1	In the absence of the Chairman, Cllr T Kitto, Vice Chair, took the Chair for the meeting.	
1	Apologies Apologies were received and accepted from Cllr J Dunn (Chairman), Cllr D Finch, Cllr M Mackie and Cllr H Blee

3	Consideration of Written Requests for Dispensations. None received.	
4	Unitary Councillor's Reports Cllr Seeva said that Cornwall Council had had a meeting at which the main topics for decision were the motion to support a letter asking the Government for a People's Vote on Brexit and a second motion regarding further debate on the Stadium for Cornwall and the desire to send a letter to the Government to ask for its commitment to the funding for the Stadium. Cllr Seeva reported that as of tomorrow he is standing down as the Conservative Group Leader. He has recently attended two meetings; the first in Westminster was to talk about improvements to the A38 and the second was a presentation on the Space Port, which looks as if it is going in the right direction. Cllr Francis asked about the pinch point on the bridge at Bodmin Parkway, on the A38. Cllr Seeva said that this work will be included in the 2020-25 schedule of improvements. Cllr Pascoe reported that at Cabinet yesterday there was discussion about the Tamar Bridge and an increase of 33% to the toll charges. An Act of Parliament will be needed to increase the Toll. Cllr Pascoe said that Parish Councillors may get enquiries regarding the proposed intention to charge people in Cornwall Council Social Housing a service charge, capped at £5 per week. Cllr Pascoe is not in favour of this service charge being levied. Cornwall Council said that it has consulted with residents but only two attended the meeting. Cllr Francis asked Cllr Pascoe if Dobwalls and Trewidland Parish Council can respond to the idea that it feels it is not a fair way to proceed. Cllr Pascoe said that she had met with Network Rail and has reminded them about the measures to prevent the travellers from pitching at Treburgie Water. Cllr Seeva said that the bollards have been installed recently.	Clerk

Repair and refurbish the existing two storey workshop, replacing doors, windows and adding additional roof windows to the front to create a useable two storey workshop. Following discussion, it was RESOLVED to support this application. Proposed by Cllr Francis, seconded by Cllr Tween with all in favour.</p> <p>PA18/10607, Bridge End, Tremabe Lane, Dobwalls, Liskeard, Cornwall. Construction of an Agricultural Building. Following discussion, it was RESOLVED to support this application. It will be situated well away from the Highway and will not impact visually on neighbouring properties.
